Church Sanctuary

The church building is intended for the worship of God and the study of his word. Therefore, it should be used only in a way that honors and glorifies God through worship, service, or Christian fellowship. The Minister is in charge of the church as he has been appointed to serve and supervise the activities in these facilities. It shall be cleared through the Pastor, when any function is to take place in the church other than regularly scheduled programs.

Candlesticks, furniture, etc., cannot be removed from the chancel area except with ministerial approval. No tacks, pins, or nails are to be used to attach decorations or markers to pews, walls, or Chancel furnishings.

It is the policy of the church that all lights and air conditioners are turned off when the building is not in use. Opening and closing of the church building must be coordinated with a member of the church trustees. All doors should be locked when the building is not in use.
