1729 - "Holy Club" started in Oxford

1784 - Methodist Episcopal Church formed

1800 - United Brethren in Christ formed

1807 - Evangelical Association formed

1830 - Methodist Protestant Church formed (splinter of Methodist Episcopal Church 1828)

1845 – Methodist Episcopal Church South formed (splinter of Methodist Episcopal Church 1844)

1855 - St. Paul formed

1867 - Center Grove formed

1939 – The Methodist Church formed from merger of Methodist Episcopal Church, Methodist Episcopal Church South, and Methodist Protestant Church

1946 – Evangelical United Brethren formed from the merger of United Brethren in Christ and the Evangelical Association

1968 – The United Methodist Church formed from the merger of the Evangelical United Brethren and The Methodist Church
